On March 19, 2020, Governor Reynolds issued a proclamation of Disaster Emergency which included a suspension of Iowa laws that would prevent the use of electronic meetings or the limitation on the number of people present at an in-person meeting site. The agenda was posted 24 hours in advance at City Hall, Anita Post Office, and the Anita Channel to give instructions on how others could participate in the meeting.

Also present were City Attorney Justin Hockenberry, Eric Steffensen with the Streets Department, and Blake Butcher.

Mayor Knutson called the public hearing to order at 6:00 p.m.
