UNFINISHED BUSINESS: D.O.T. ACCESSIBLE SIDEWALK PROJECT/HWY 83/MAIN STREET PROJECT, ANITA URBAN RENEWAL PLAN-TIF REVENUE.

The Anita City Council met in regular session Wednesday, October 14, 2015 at City Hall at 7:30 p.m. Roll call of officers was taken. Mayor Miller presided and all council members were present. Also present were Craig Wahlert, Amanda Wahlert, Ailey Wahlert, Daphna Wahlert, Kelsi Eden, Ben Daughenbaugh, Chris Karns, Rose Watson, Nancy Lund, Neil Aupperle, John Pollock, Dave Christensen, Jim Mailander, and Gene Andrews.

At 7:30p.m. Mayor Miller called the meeting to order. Motion by T. Harris and seconded by M. Harris to approve the agenda. Ayes: All.

Dave Christensen addressed the council regarding stop signs that were recently placed on Locust and Walnut Streets. He referenced the Manual of Unified Traffic Control Device, a guideline for placement of traffic control devices adopted by the Federal government. Discussion was held regarding the justification of the signs. City Attorney, Mailander advised that he will research the written law on who governs specific types of roads as well as

any case law pertaining to this and will give his legal opinion at the next regular council meeting. Therefore this item was tabled and will be discussed again at the November meeting.

Agenda item #4 was tabled due to no representation.

Neil Aupperle advised the council that the agenda was incorrect, that he was not present at the meeting to discuss a tree ordinance but instead wanted to present a citizens concern and complaint. His concern was in reference to the lack of cooperation that he received from the City in their legal opinion regarding a deed that he provided to clarify the location of his property line in a claim made against him and later resulted in a lawsuit. He stated that the lawsuit could have been prevented if the City had acted appropriately. Other concerns included charges listed on an invoice that the City paid for legal representation in the case. Mayor Miller advised there will be no additional discussion regarding the case as it has already been settled by the courts.

Motion by Bohnsack and seconded by T. Harris approving RESOLUTION 15-16 authorizing internal advance from the City's Local Option Fund to Tax Increment LMI Revenue fund in order to undertake an urban renewal project. All council members voted Aye.

Discussion was held regarding nuisance abatement at 903 Main Street. Additional discussion was held regarding other nuisance properties.

John Pollock presented items regarding streets and commented on concerns. Committee council representatives will follow-up.

It was the consensus of the council that reserve signs should be placed on electrical-paid sites at the truck parking area.

Additional discussion was had on the Hwy 83/Main Street Project. The City Clerk has scheduled a phone conference with bonding attorney John Danos at Dorsey & Whitney to review funding options as well as contract language for an agreement with the D.O.T.

Motion by J. Bohnsack and seconded by W. Jessen to adjourn. Ayes: All.
