The Regular City Council Meeting of the Anita City Council was held June 10, 2020 with Mayor Harris presiding. In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, a special meeting of the Anita City Council was held electronically utilizing the platform. Chapter 21.8 of the Iowa Code does permit an electronic meeting where all members participate remotely when an in-person meeting is impossible or impractical, which is certainly true during this crisis. On March 19, 2020, Governor Reynolds issued a proclamation of Disaster Emergency which included a suspension of Iowa laws that would prevent the use of electronic meetings or the limitation on the number of people present at an in-person meeting site. The agenda was posted 24 hours in advance at Rolling Hills Bank, First National Bank, City Hall, Anita Post Office, the Anita Channel and Main Street Market to give instructions on how others could participate in the meeting.

Council Members present were: John Knutson, Ben Daughenbaugh, Mark Harris and Kevin Littleton. Absent was Tim Wheelock.

Also present were Jim Mailander, Dave Winther, Mike Tibken, Randy Gregersen and Tammi Williamson.

Motion by M Harris; second by Littleton to approve minutes of the May 13, 2020 Council Meeting with a correction to only a camper trailer being removed from 14 Sun Valley Dr and to approve minutes of the May 27, 202 Special City Council Meeting. Ayes: All. Motion Carried.

Motion by Littleton; second by Daughenbaugh to approve the clerk/treasurer's report. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Motion by Daughenbaugh; second by M Harris to approve the invoices as presented. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Motion by M Harris; second by Daughenbaugh to approve Cigarette Permits for Casey's, Main St Market and Olsen Fuel Supply.

Motion by Littleton; second by M Harris to approve Resolution # 20-24 "TRANSFER OF PROPERTY AT 14 SUN VALLEY DR, ANITA FOR \$1,000." Dave will be removing 2 sheds and Randy will be taking care of the rest within 3 months. Ayes: Knutson, Littleton, M Harris, Daughenbaugh. Nays: None. Absent: Wheelock. Motion Carried.

Motion by Knutson; Second by M Harris for the council to apply for the CDBG grant again this year through SWIPCO. Their decision was to apply for the Owner Occupied: Exterior Improvements section of the grant. Ayes: All. Motion carried.

Motion by Daughenbaugh; second by M Harris to approve amendment to the Owner-Engineer agreement with JEO for the Waste Water Sewer project. Ayes: All. Motion carried. An update is needed due to JEO having to change direction on where the electric line is going to be placed for easements due to land owners' refusal to sign allowing the city to install an electric line as they had previously designed.

The city will not allow the capping off of sewer lines for a way to not pay the sewer availability fee. This is not in the best interest of the city as it will cause more costs down the road if anyone were to want to connect back to the city sewer.

A committee was formed to study septic systems within city limits. Discussion tabled.

The City of Anita will be assessing properties with unpaid, delinquent Sewer Connection Availability fees annually, as a special assessment to Property Taxes.

Motion by M Harris; second by Knutson to approve paying for a new roof on the low income apartment buildings, with a cap of \$20,000. Ayes: All. Motion carried. They will be putting 30 year shingles on the building.

The Street Department was discussed. There is a tree on Chestnut Street that is unhealthy and rotten. Dave says that the tree is unsafe and they will be taking the tree down. Also we will be receiving a quote for asphalt to put down on alleys throughout town.

Motion by Littleton; second by M Harris to approve Resolution # 20-25 "SETTING HOURLY WAGES OF CITY EMPLOYEES" was tabled until the June 24, 2020 council meeting.

Motion by Littleton; second by Daughenbaugh to approve Resolution # 20-26 "APPROVING YEAR END TRANSFERS." Ayes: Knutson, Littleton, M Harris, Daughenbaugh. Nays: None. Absent: Wheelock. Motion Carried.

Project Playground installation is being pushed back due to COVID.

Discussion held on nuisance abatements.

City Hall will remain closed to the public and by appointment only, Tuesday/Thursday, 8 am to 12 pm.

The next meeting will be for FY20 3<sup>nd</sup> Budget Amendment on June 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 with the regular monthly Anita City Council meeting on July 8, 2020 at 7:30 pm at City Hall, if able, or via electronic meeting utilizing zoom. Details will be posted if either of the meetings will be held electronically due to COVID-19.

Motion by Littleton; second by Knutson to adjourn. Ayes: All. Motion Carried, meeting adjourned at 9:03 p.m.
